



YCT Seeks Director of LGBTQ+ Initiatives

Position Brief: The Director of LGBTQ+ Initiatives will be responsible for advancing YCT LGBTQ+ initiatives for our alumni, students, and the broader community, with the goals of (1) making YCT communities and religious leaders prioritize and implement a culture of welcome and (2) to advance the discourse, awareness and sensitivity around these issues.

The Director will work closely with the President & Rosh HaYeshiva, Dean, and Director of Alumni Engagement.

Specific responsibilities include:

- Serving on our LGBTQ+ Advisory Committee
- Heading development of community-based initiatives
- Working with alumni and driving effort to develop and promote standards of welcome for YCT-led communities
- Coordinating production of Torah and halakhic writings relevant to these issues
- Working with Dean to expand and deepen YCT curriculum and training in these areas
- Ensure ongoing engagement with, and input from LGBTQ+ individuals, YCT *musmakhim* in the field, students, and relevant individuals and institutions, on these initiatives
- Partner with other organizations and communities to further these goals

Reporting to the President, this is a quarter-time position to start, with the hope for growth as the initiatives take off and there is more work to do. Pay range is \$30,000-\$40,000 and commensurate with experience.

Our Ideal Candidate is an accomplished project manager: having envisioned, strategized, planned, collaborated, and managed major projects through execution, and a person with ties to the LGBTQ+ community. They are a team player with excellent interpersonal skills.
